NOTICE OF MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL TO LEVY TAXES FOR 1916. Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Tacoma, on Monday, Sept. 20, 1915, passed the following resolution adopting public expense estimates for the year 1916, and fixed Monday, October 4th, 1915, as the time, and the Council Chamber in the City Hall, as the place of meeting to hear objections and make the tax levies effective.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA: That the following are the estimates of the amounts required to meet the public expense of the City of Tacoma for the year 1916, and to be raised by taxation in said city and also an estimate of the receipts of said City for the year 1916, from sources other than direct taxation.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk publish said estimates in "The Tacoma Times" an official newspaper, on Monday, Sept. 20, 1915, and on Monday, Sept. 27th, 1915, together with a notice that the Council will meet on the first Monday in October, 1915, at 10 o'clock a. m. at the Council Chamber in the City Hall for the purpose of making tax levies, when and where any taxpayer, who may appear, will be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed tax levies.
