## FIREBUG GOT START HERE

OAKLAND, Cal., Oct. 1.—Charles Lester Burright, confessed arsonist, told Police Captain Peterson today that he had started on his career of crime, which had netted \$40,000 in six years, in Tacoma in 1909.

It was in the Sound city that he and his partner, Currier, made a formal agreement to go into arson as a business.

One plan was to burn residences before the lumber bills were paid, and then flee with the insurance; another to build houses with many windows, flues and drafts so that the fires would spread rapidly. No insurance man was ever victimized more than once.
