



ORDINANCE NO. 6242—AN ORDINANCE creating the October Salary Fund, appropriating and transferring to said fund the several funds of the City of Tacoma, the sum of \$67,478.91 to pay the salaries and compensations of officers and employees of said City for the month of October, 1916, including compensation of employees discharged during said month, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Controller of said City of Tacoma, has submitted claims for salaries and compensation of officers and employees of said City of Tacoma, for the month of October, 1916, in the sum of \$67,478.91, and

Section 1. That there be and is hereby created in the treasury of the City of Tacoma, a fund to be called the "October Salary Fund" from which fund shall be paid the salaries and compensation of officers and employees of said City of Tacoma for the month of October, 1916, including the compensation of employees discharged during said month.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated and transferred to said October Salary Fund from the several funds of the City of Tacoma, the sum of \$67,478.91, to-wit:

From the General Fund \$39,719.91 From the Light Fund... 15,157.85 From the Water Fund... 9,661.48 From the Library Fund... 2,024.54 From the Dock Dept. Fund... 915.33

Total... \$67,478.91 Section 3. That the proper officers be authorized to draw warrants on said funds for the amount of \$67,478.91.

Section 4. An emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication. Passed Nov. 3, 1916. Attest: W. D. NICKEL, Mayor. City Clerk.
