

Dear Miss Grey: Will you kindly inform through your columns the girl who signs herself "Try to Keep Straight on \$6 Per" in Monday's Times that if she would communicate with you she will find a letter for her from a respectable couple with an offer that may help make this old world a tiny bit more livable for her if she wishes to take advantage of it.

She tells the truth when she says married women are helping put girls onto the street. For one woman who is compelled to work, there are 20—yes, and more—that are simply working for pin money, prettier clothes and killing time; who have lovely homes and good husbands. I know lots of them.

There is a mother's pension for widows with children to support, but what protection has a young girl who is thrown on her own resources to shuffle for herself? You know what \$6 a week means to girls that have no home. It's plain h— and nothing else, and girls that do live straight on it (and thousands do) that is, not live, but just about exist, certainly have my utmost honor and respect, and ought to have every body's else.

Hundreds of these girls need a little help, not charity; they have their pride, too, but if only some family that has an extra room or will share one, let them have it at a lower rate, give them a chance to launder their few clothes, let them use the family machine, if they like to sew, give them a chance at the stove to cook their own meals (dozens do it on a gas jet in a little 2x4 hall room), and give them a lift now and then, and you can ask enough to defray expenses of lighting and gas or fuel as the case may be.

Q—I wish advice on giving a birthday party. I cannot afford an elaborate menu. How should invitations read, and should boys be invited? A—Invite the boys if your parents are willing. A simple form of note, written in the first person, is best.

Q—Should the walls of a bedroom be painted or papered? A—Painted walls are more hygienic. Pale tints are restful to the eye and attractive as well. Such walls can be wiped frequently with oiled cloths. The ceiling should be some light tint.
