NEW YORK, Nov. 29.—Snowy to friends in New York, showing Baker, the Australian promoter, that all is not well between him has written an indignant letter, and Les Darcy, the sensational

## Shevlin As Player and Coach; He's 'Miracle Man' of Football

Tom Shevlin, on the strength of his work at the head of the Yale staff of coaches, is the "Miracle Man" of football. Called for in a pinch, he put a joke eleven, which had lost to minor teams, into such shape it looked like a real team against Princeton and Harvard.

The second time Shevlin pulled a miracle. In 1910, after Yale was walloped 21 to 0 by Brown, he revamped the New Haven eleven so well Yale beat Princeton 5 to 3 and held Harvard to a scoreless tie. When not performing miracles at Yale, Shevlin is in the lumber business at Minneapolis.

## Great Stadiums, Seating Thousands For Legalized Boxing In Australia

To me, the most interesting feature of the boxing game in Australia is the matter of fact way in which it is conducted. One large company, the Stadium, Ltd., controls boxing in Australia. It has three huge fight stadiums, in Sydney, Brisbane and Melbourne, and all of the big matches in Australia are held in one of these three. Of course, there are smaller independent stadiums in other parts of the country, and there is no monopoly on the game. The boxing people, just like the theater people, all look upon the one in concern as "boss" of the boxing business. In the vaudeville business, as a parallel example, every variety theater in Australia is handled by one concern, and every act that goes into the country is booked through one office. No one thinks of trying to start competition in either line.

It was thought for a long time that Snowy Baker, well known boxing man, was head of the Stadium company. He was the acting head, and nobody had any idea but that he was the company. A recent suit in Australia, however, brought out the fact that John Wren, race-track man and horse owner, was the power behind the concern—the real owner of the corporation.

Sydney Stadium Larger. The Sydney stadium is the largest of the three, seating about 7,000. The other two stadiums seat 5,000 persons. At one time they were entirely open and unprotected from the elements, but in recent years the company has put roofs on its buildings, and now all the bouts are held in the evening, as in most other places. The stadiums are circular in shape. The ring is square, of course, and set on a raised platform in the center and bottom of the rings of seats. The first few rows of ringside seats are flat, but the others rise in a perfect circle, just like they do in the Tacoma high school stadium. In this way, everyone gets a seat with an unobstructed view of the ring.

Referee Prejudicial. Harold Baker, brother of Snowy, referee in Sydney. Snowy makes all the matches. Harry is very strongly prejudiced against Americans, and throughout a bout he keeps talking to the American boxer, warning him against foul blows, and trying to distract his attention from his opponent.

Tom Andrews of Milwaukee, the well known sporting man, is American representative of the Stadium company, Ltd., of Australia. It was through him that I obtained my contract.

An American going to Australia signs a contract in this country by which he guarantees to box five times in the Australian stadiums against anybody of his own class whom the company wants to match him with. His fare both ways is paid, and under normal conditions he gets a good price for his contract. The main events are all for 20 rounds, with the two usual preliminaries of six and 10 rounds. The boxer gets all expenses paid in traveling to and from the various stadiums where he is to box. \$22,000 House. The best house this year was

when McGoorty and Darcy fought at Sydney. There were \$22,000 in paid admissions. I was in McGoorty's corner and Mac boxed a whirlwind fight against the plucky Australian boy. But he lost in the 16th round, simply because Darcy was by far the better man.

One of the interesting novelties of the Australian ring is an automatic time clock, which taps off the rounds and keeps accurate time, thus preventing a timekeeper from shortening or lengthening a round to give a boxer the advantage.

This clock has a large dial, and instead of the 12 spaces for hours it has just four numbers on its face, and one hand. When the fight starts, the gong rings and the clock begins running. At the end of three minutes it rings for the end of the round, and in another minute it rings again for the opening of the next round.

That clock is a wonderful advantage to a boxer. He can see while fighting just how much
