
## SCHOOL CONTEST RULES COMPLETE

Formal rules for country school athletic contests were decided on yesterday and will be forwarded to the principals this week. Soccer punting and volley ball serving will constitute the competitive events.

The committee of the Pierce County Schools' Athletic and Recreation association which formulated the plans expects to give trophies to the winners in these events, which were chosen because they will not incur any added expense to the schools and because the small schools can compete with the larger one.

Handicaps have been allowed the boys of the different grades in punting contests, enabling them to compete with the older boys. The committee suggests that a permanent punting plot be laid off with points marking the different distances. This, it is thought, will do away with the trouble of unwinding a tape after every kick.

School teachers can start the training and competition at any time, keeping the records until completed when they will be sent to the athletic committee.

## Van Hits Tree; City Gets Bill


