Flora Finch uses limburger as "first aid" in making faces while before the camera.


Leah Baird, Vitagraph actress, built a special house, steamheated with private bath, for her pet Collie dog. And now the dog is dead. Leah mourns.

LONDON, Dec. 30.—An American woman may become the vicerine of India as the result of the conscription issue.
