

# MILK KEEPS UP HIGH STANDARD

Tacoma's milk supply continues to maintain its remarkable high standard of purity.

A test of samples taken from dairy wagons last week was completed today by Prof. Frank Bohl of the U. S. department of agriculture and Prof. Marcus Dey of the state agricultural department.

These experts had been so surprised last summer by results of milk tests here that they had refused to believe their own figures, and had made a second test, which brought out the same proof of purity of milk.

Figures today from the new test show that the dairies whose score for pure milk was of high per centage last October, when the last test was made, have kept up their standard, while other dairies have improved. The lowest score in 31 dairies is 70.75,
