DUBLIN, Mexico, March 31.—When he tortured and put to death five Mexicans on the Corralitos ranch here a few days ago, Bandit Villa nearly lost his own life, it was reported today. One of his victims, Mucio Polanco, leaped upon Villa and was strangling him when Villista officers beat him senseless with the butts of their guns. The murder of five members of the Polanco family was said to have been intended to warn Mexicans not to have dealings with Americans. Villa searched for two daughters of the family, but they escaped him.

## Booze Floods Justice

J. B. Pettigrew was found guilty yesterday of selling liquor at the Palace hotel, after the jury had been given a smell of the confiscated booze. Prosecutor Thompson, in the excitement of the trial, forgot about two bottles of the liquid which were standing on the desk before him. He brought his fist down on one of them with a bang that broke it, and rivulets of witness christened Justice Graham's desk. Pettigrew drew a sentence of 90 days in jail and a fine of \$100.

## Probe Gasoline Trust

WASHINGTON, D. C., March 31.—Government investigation to determine whether a criminal conspiracy is back of the rise in the price of gasoline, is demanded in a resolution adopted by the senate today. It was introduced by Senator Martine, and declares the oil market is controlled by and the prices fixed by a trust, the Standard Oil company. Many senators joined in urging the investigation.

LONDON, March 31.—The most important big guns needed by the British army have been held up in all their stages of manufacture by the strike of the Clyde munitions workers, according to the statement made to the house of commons yesterday by David Lloyd-George, munitions minister. William Pringle, labor leader, blamed the government for breaking off negotiations.
