## German Embassy Demands Papers

Lakes with a motor boat armed with machine guns. "I was then requested to assist in a scheme for the invasion of Canada by a force recruited from reservists in the United States, aided by German warships then in the Pacific.

Proposed by Attachés. "This scheme, which was proposed by von Papen and Boy-Ed, later was abandoned by the advice of Bernstorff.

"Next von Papen asked me to confer with two Irishmen, who proposed the dynamiting of railway junctions, grain elevators and the locks of the canals connecting the Great Lakes.

"It was hoped this to terrify Canada, preventing the Dominion from aiding the mother country."

The alleged confession outlines the schemes of von Papen. It says in part:

"A few days after I met von Papen, I was asked my opinion of the scheme suggested by a certain Schumacher for raiding towns on the coast of the Great
