

EXPECT 15,000 IN LINE

That "not less than 10,000 in line" slogan for the Tacoma preparedness parade is to be beaten a thousand ways.
 Between 12,000 and 15,000 men, women and children will be in line on the morning of July 4, to demonstrate their demand for preparedness, according to the estimates of Grand Marshal H. G. Winsor, who has completed arrangement for the march.

It will take more than two hours for the 15 divisions of the big parade to pass the reviewing stand to be located near 11th and Broadway.

The long line will start moving at 10 a. m. sharp from the city hall, proceeding down Pacific avenue to 15th street, thence up Broadway to 9th street where it will disband.

Those who have been invited to review the parade are Mayor Fawcett, Gov. Lister and staff, Adj. Gen. Maurice Thompson of the National Guard of Washington; Rear Admiral Rogers, retired; Col. William M. Inglis and staff and Mrs. Luther P. Bradley, widow of Gen. Bradley.

Music of the kind that warms the blood and stirs the feet to action will not be lacking. There will be at least eight bands in line, and probably more.

At the head of the 15 divisions will make up the line will be Commissioner of Public Safety Pettit with a squad of police. Then will come the Montanara Festo committee, consisting of C. H. Manley, chairman; William F. Geiger, Richard Vaeth, Charles A. Briggs, J. O. Peterson, Guy K. Llewellyn and Dr. R. V. Hoyt, followed by a band.

Grand Marshal Winsor will be next in line with his honorary staff, including Maj. Everett G. Griggs, James Dege, W. H. Dickson, Dr. E. C. Wheeler, Elwell H. Hoyt, Maj. C. O. Bates, George ... Boardman, James R. Thompson, William Jones and George S. West.

Then will come the 15 divisions, including the organization which will march.
