

Roosevelt today announced that he will probably make five more speeches in the interests of the republican presidential candidate. Today is the colonel's birthday. He is 53, and says he is as replete with Roosevelt ginger and pep as of old. He looks it today and he looked it yesterday when he was given a reception that everyone here said was noisier, bigger and more enthusiastic than those recently accorded President Wilson and Hughes here.
