FREIGHT LINE TO GENOA PLANNED (United Press Leased Wire) SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 2.—Announcement of a freight line between Genoa, Italy, and San Francisco via the Panama canal, and another between Genoa and New York, is made today by Marquis Lucilio Riccaiboni of Rome, who is here purchasing vessels. The freight steamer California, formerly the British ship Alga, was purchased for the interests the marquis represents, \$1,350,000 in cash being paid, a new war-time price record.
