WHEREAS, the City Controller of the City of Tacoma, has submitted claims for salaries and compensation of officers and employees of the City of Tacoma, for the last half of the month of October, 1916, in the sum of \$33,068.72. NOW, THEREFORE, Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated and transferred the sum of \$33,068.72 from the several funds of the City of Tacoma to the October Salary Fund, to pay the salaries and compensation of officers and employees of the City of Tacoma for the last half of the month of October, 1916, including the compensation of employees discharged during that time.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated and transferred to said October Salary Fund, from the October Debt Fund, the sum of \$33,068.72 to-wit: From the General Fund... \$19,867.44 From the Light Fund... 5,882.35 From the Water Fund... 4,920.80 From the Public Debt Fund... 508.53 From the Library Fund... 1,891.63 Total... \$33,068.72

Section 3. That the proper officers be authorized to draw warrants on said fund for the amount of \$33,068.72.

Section 4. An emergency exists and the ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication. Passed Nov. 3, 1916.
