POLICE MAKE A GUN LIST

Before the end of the present week, every revolver, rifle, or other weapon on sale in any store in Tacoma will be listed by the police.

Detectives began the work Tuesday of taking an inventory of every gun in the second-hand stores, pawn shops and hardware stores of the city. The manufacturers' numbers of every weapon are being recorded in books at police headquarters.

By comparing with these records, the police will know if any local dealer is disobeying the order placing a ban on the purchase of firearms. Arrests of any dealer selling guns without permit will occur, whenever the police hear of such a case.

Refuse Movie House Permit

Attempts to establish a new motion picture theater on the Broadway floor of the Johnson hotel, 1125 Broadway, failed Wednesday when the city council refused to amend the building code. The hotel building is not of fire-proof construction, and under the building laws, no movie house could be located in such a structure.

Smuel Sifall, who wanted the ordinance changed permitting him to open a theater in the building, had leased the room for three years before investigating the law. Fire Chief Carlson, Fire Marshal Chantler and Building Inspector Snyder all objected to the proposed movie house.
