## "THE BATTLE OF MANILA" The Greatest Pyrotechnic Display Ever in Walla Walla

The Grand Spectacular Bombardment Scene,

### "THE BATTLE OF MANILA."

This historical naval engagement is depicted in a realistic manner, the roar of the cannons, mingling with the incessant noise of the rapid fire guns, the flight of the shells, the interchange of firing and signalling is well shown; the blowing up of some of the ships and the actual sinking of the Spanish flagship is plainly discernable; nine battleships are shown in action. This scene is 250 feet long. You will be delighted and fascinated with this exhibition and would not have missed it for anything.

The Huge Mechanical Set Piece—Two performing bears, larger than life size dancing and keeping time to the music from the band.

This is the most dazzling and awe-inspiring exhibition of Fireworks ever devised by human ingenuity. Preceding the bombardment scene and afterwards, one of the greatest arrays of fireworks ever in Walla Walla will be shown.

Aerial salutes, French balloons, magical illuminations, mammoth shells silver domes, shell discharges with clouds of emeralds and rubies; the great 18 1-2 in. shell showing the Golden Palm; swarms of dragon flies, Chrysanthemum bomb shells, sapphires with golden rain; aerial whistling contest, by swarms of lightning bugs, as they wriggle to earth; the Electric Weeping Willow Trees; three triple action Gillouche Wheels, each 20 feet in diameter; bouquet of Rayonet Tourbillions, the famous spider shell, blazing sun cluster shell; hanging chains and festoons hanging in the sky; golden and silver diamond shells; the great Silver Nyanza Falls; and the finale motto "Good Night," in letters of rich colored lancework.

Elsewhere in this paper you will find the whole program. Just read it over and see what a magnificent exhibition it will be.

### THE GIANT SET PIECES.

Alladin's Jeweled Tree—A fine effective design, 60 feet high, the foliage continually changing its colors.

Two revolving fountains, each one being 60 feet high.

Gigantic Set piece—**National Pillars**—Three pillars of light, 10 feet in diameter and 50 feet high; one red, one white, one blue.

**The Silver Nyanza Falls**—A dazzling torrent of brilliant white fire, 100 feet in width and falling from a height of 50 feet clear to the ground

### TWO GIGANTIC SET PIECES

The portrait of Admiral Dewey and the motto "My Country 'Tis of Thee" in an outline of fire, while at the same time a brilliant background of batteries, colors, fountains, tourbillions, scussions and streamers are going off.

Grand Eruption of 72 Mammoth Italian Color Fountains and seven Gerbe Cascades. The design is 250 feet long and 50 feet high.
