WASHINGTON FARM BUYS ONE HOLSTEIN BULL FOR \$106,000

E. A. Stuart, of the Carnation Stock Farms has paid the record price of the world for a six-month-old bull calf.

It was the great June sale of the Holstein-Friesian Association, held at Milwaukee, Wis., June 6 & 7, 1918, that the Carnation Stock Farms, represented by Elbridge A. Stuart of Seattle, presented a check for \$106,000 in payment for that noted son of a famous Holstein family.

Champion Sylvia Johanna is the youngest son of May Echo Sylvia, the world's greatest milk cow. She is the only 40-pound cow in the world with three records over 36 pounds of butter and she has another 36.94. She is the only cow to make over 1,000 pounds of milk in seven days or over 12,800 pounds in 100 days; she is the only cow to have four records of over 750 pounds of milk in 7 days—three of them are over \$50—and her four 30-day records are just as good. The sire of Champion Sylvia Johanna is King Echo Sylvia Johanna a son of Belle Model Johanna 2nd a twice 37-pound cow with a third record of over 32 pounds. At 4 years she is the only cow of the breed to pounds of butter, and having a daughter with the same average. The sire of Champion Sylvia Johanna is himself a grandson of May Echo Sylvia, by a son of King of the Pontiacs, and Pontiac Artis.

KILL FLIES AND SAVE LIVES IS SLOGAN OF FLY FIGHTERS

The preservation of food was never more important than it is now. The preservation of life was never more important than it is now.

That is the reason that the prevention of the house fly ought to be a campaign in every home this year. Kill flies and save lives is the slogan of fly fighters.

The United States government recommends for the destruction of house flies formaldehyde or sodium salicylate. These solutions are convenient to handle, easily diluted, and they attract flies.

Or, mix one tablespoon of cream, one of ground black pepper and one of brown sugar. Put in a saucer and darken the room except for one window where the mixture is set. It is poisonous to flies.

To clear the house of flies, burn pyrethrum powder. This stupefies the flies, but they must be SWEEPED UP and BURNED.

Borax is especially useful around farms and out of doors. One pound of borax to twelve bushels of manure will not injure the quality of the latter as a fertilizer. The borax should be scattered over the manure and sprinkled with water. Lye, chloride of lime or copperas dissolved in water, crude carbolic acid or any sort of disinfectant may be used in vaults.

Kill at once every fly you can find and burn his body. The killing of just one fly NOW means there will be billions and trillions less next summer. The conditions produced by the long and severe winter have made difficult the removal and proper disposal of refuse and filth accumulations that will facilitate the breeding of disease-germ-carrying flies. Clean up your own premises; insist that your neighbors do likewise.


