

### HERE'S HOW TO MAKE GOOD SEXOMETER FOR ONLY 10 CTS.

Lynden poultrymen who have been reading about the new devices that will tell the sex of the chick in the egg, will be interested in the discovery of a Ripon, Cal. man, as told in the Pacific Poultryman this month, as follows:

Mr. Preshaw says that for ten cents one of these sexometers can be made that is just as efficient as the ones made in Germany and being sold in this country for \$5 apiece. With this little device, he says, you can tell the sex of anything alive, the sex and fertility of eggs, the vitality of bulb roots and grains. He says he wants to pass this information along to the poultry breeders without cost, as he thinks everyone should know about it, and as its use will save the poultry industry many dollars wasted every year by trying to hatch infertile eggs. He claims that the fertile eggs can be separated from the infertile ones and will also tell whether the eggs will hatch a rooster or a pullet.

"Its mechanism is very simple, requiring only a silver dime and a piece of common sewing thread about six inches long which is fastened to the dime. It is used by holding the string between the thumb and finger and letting the coin hang over the object under test. If the dime swings in a circle it indicates a female and if it swings in a pendulum movement it is a male."
