Plant Lice on Brussels Sprouts.
Plant lice is the curse of the more delicate members of the cabbage family, and Brussels sprouts are often badly infested with them. The crop needs close watching, says T. Greiner in Farm and Fireside. If you have a good knapsack sprayer (as any gardener should) the task is comparatively simple. Make a strong tobacco tea or a kerosene emulsion, or take plain hot water or soapsuds at a temperature of about 100 degrees, and spray it with considerable force on the plants, holding the nozzle rather close to the stalks so that the force of the spray reaches all the tiny heads. I have a nozzle that is bent at about a right angle to the main direction, so that I can reach underneath the leaves and spray upward or in any direction I please.

Fruit Rot of Tomatoes.
Fruit rot of tomatoes is combated with more or less successfully by pruning and training vines to admit light and air, together with the destruction of all diseased fruits to prevent the spread of infection.
