NORTHWEST NEWS.

As a result of the efforts of Senator Ankeny and Congressman Jones, additional allotments of funds have been made to Yakima irrigation projects as follows: Sunnyside project, \$350,000; Tieton project, \$250,000; Yakima Indian reservation, \$100,000. This makes the total allotments for these projects up to date \$2,000,000.

Colbert P. Blair, aged 100 years, 5 months and 17 days, died at Pendleton, June 16.

A report from Dayton says that as about 3500 sheep belonging to A. Magallon of Walla Walla were being driven up the street, the sheep, seeking warmth, piled up in the street, where nearly 200 were smothered before they could be separated and driven to shelter.

Much excitement exists over the mysterious killing of John P. Demuth, aged 35, a rancher who has resided in Stevens county for many years. Demuth was shot on June 13th by a person unknown.

The second annual meeting of the Washington State Elk's association met at Tacoma on June 14.

The sage brush badge worn by Major Fred R. Reed, editor of the Burley, Idaho, Bulletin, who represented El Korah temple of Boise City at the Mystic Shrine convolve in Chicago, was awarded first prize for being the most unique emblem at the gathering.

The four-masted gasoline schooner Argos, from Port Gamble for San Francisco, is on fire 35 miles south of Cape Flattery. The crew has gone and the schooner has been abandoned.

The lumber and shingle manufacturers of the state, in a joint meeting held in Seattle on June 15, decided to reject the new minimum weight schedule submitted by the G. S. and N. P. railroads, to go into effect July 15. The committee of six which recently conferred in St. Paul with the heads of the railroads to secure the withdrawal of the schedule for which this is a substitute, was given charge of the matter again.

The home of Herman Voss, near Freese, Idaho, was the scene of an explosion of 50 pounds of dynamite one day last week, and how a number of people near escaped injury is a mystery or a miracle. The dynamite was stored in a building not more than 50 feet from the dwelling and was touched off by a bullet from a squirrel gun fired by a young son of Mr. Voss, who with two other children was standing within a few feet of the explosion. The building, 16x24 feet in size, was wiped out completely, not a board being left, and a great hole was torn in the ground. Not a person was injured and there was no damage to the dwelling except a couple of broken windows.
