

FUN ON THE SINGLE ROPE SWING.



A swing with a single rope will furnish as much fun, if not more, than a swing of the regulation kind. Bore a hole in the end of a soap box, pass the rope through and knot it at the bottom. Affix the loose end of the rope to a branch of a tree as far from the trunk as possible—and there you are!

Practice will make perfect in the control of this swing. Grasp the rope high up, stand back, and with a quick jerk lift yourself and straddle the

board, which should be just high enough from the ground to enable the toes to touch. You can swing in any direction or go round in a circle like a "merry-go-round."

NATURAL SOAP TREE

An excellent soap, possessing no alkaline properties, is extracted in Algeria from the fruit of a tree known to botanists as *sapindus utilis*. The fruit is about the size of a horse-chestnut, and the saponaceous substance is cheaply extracted with the aid of water or alcohol. This natural soap tree grows also in India, China and Japan.

THE SPONGE ANIMAL.

Aristotle was the first man to venture an opinion that the sponge was an animal. But up to about the middle of the eighteenth century most naturalists considered sponges to be plants. Some, indeed, supposed that they were merely condensed foam of the sea; others, a sort of shell formed by a kind of seaworm often found residing in a live sponge. As a matter of fact, the sponge is now classed as an animal, but it is an animal of such simple type that in many ways it is below some plants.

THE TINY FLAGELLATA.

So small are the flagellata—tiny sea organisms—that 30,000 inhabit a single cubic inch of water. Authorities are still divided in opinion as to whether to class them as low animals or as plants. They resemble vegetable cells in color, being of a bright green.

REPUBLICANS AT SPOKANE BRIDGE

A rousing republican meeting was held last night in the Spokane Bridge schoolhouse, the edifice being packed to the doors. Ed. Canfield, precinct committee man, presided. The speakers were Hon. Walker A. Henry, candidate for state senator from the Fourth district; Hon. J. B. Lindley, candidate for representative from the Fifth district, and Dayton H. Stewart, candidate for reelection as county assessor. Messrs. Henry and Lindley discussed the local aspects

of state issues and explained the inconsistencies of the democracy in turning down good railway commission men like Senators Tolman and Hallett and Representative Quinn for men whose attitude is not of record. Assessor Stewart talked on revenue and taxation and explained many things about the existing laws. He also made it plain to the people that he had been grossly and maliciously misrepresented by the Morning Nopolity press of this city.

BERNHARDT 60 YEARS OLD

PARIS, Oct. 22.—It seems difficult to realize that Mme. Bernhardt, the "Divine Sarah," who has just returned from a most triumphant engagement in London, is three score years old. Such is the fact, however, the great actress having first seen the light of day just 60 years ago today at 5 Rue de L'Ecole de Medicine, in this city. Her mother was a Jewess, who had migrated to Paris from Berlin. Her grandfather was an optician of Amsterdam, and there she spent her earliest childhood.

is due the credit of discovering Sarah Bernhardt's talent. When all other critics were silent he announced that though her acting was that of a school girl, her elocution was perfect. She was eight months at the Comedie Francaise, when she boxed the ears of Mlle. Nathalie, her senior, and left for other fields. Her first real success was in 1869, when she appeared as the Florentine page in "Le Paganini."

At a convent at Versailles, where she was sent at the age of 7, she became notorious for the violence of her temper. In 1859 she entered the Paris conservatoire and became a pupil of Provost and Samson. In two years she gained the second prize for tragedy, and the next year the same for comedy.

On August 11, 1862, she made her debut at the Theater Francaise in "Iphigenie." To Francisque Sarcey and Marshall meet at Ithaca.


