
A. U. S. RECEIVERSHIP FOR SANTO DOMINGO

The Novel Scheme Which Roosevelt Will Probably Put Into Effect—Island Would Have Been Annexed to This Country in 1869 But for the Opposition of Chas. Sumner.

By Jacob Waldock. WASHINGTON, Jan. 10.—Santo Domingo, torn by revolution, misgoverned and despoiled, is soon to feel the chastening influence of "the big stick."

Officials of the highest rank in the administration say that such action is inevitable. President Roosevelt is said, on the best authority, to hold that view of the case.


THE RULERS OF SANTO DOMINGO.

A Land of Chaos. In the past the order of things has been very much unsettled. The country has been in a chronic state of revolution. There have been nearly a dozen presidents in five years.

From the standpoint of novelty it would seem that the people ought to welcome a receivership. The country has had autocratic, monarchical and republican forms of government.

In a similar predicament given the country to Spain. The latter held it from 1861 to 1865. Baez thought it would be a good scheme to deliver the republic to the United States.


