


COAL STOCK CLIMBS

International Coal & Coke continued to strengthen and sales were made as high as 78 cents. This is the high figure the stock has attained for months. There was some little activity in

snowstorm around \$1.55, largely due to short covering. The market was dominated by a summer dullness and transactions were light, with fluctuations only nominal.

IT'S A FINE DRINK OF WATER YOU GET WHEN YOU EAT A POTATO



THE CHEMISTRY OF THE POTATO.

A potato is not "a thing of beauty," but it is practically "a joy forever." In the anatomy of the potato notice the proportion of each ingredient. The bulk is water. Figure 1 is the proportion of fat, 2 is the bulk of woody fiber, 3 is the nitrogen and 4 is the bulk size of the mineral matter.

The chemistry shows the following substances and amounts: Water 78.0 per cent, Starch 18.5 per cent, Nitrogen 2.0 per cent, Mineral matter 1.0 per cent, Woody substance 0.4 per cent, Fat 0.1 per cent. If within a year one eats 100 pounds of potatoes there will be 78

pounds water, 18.5 pounds starch, 1 pound mineral matter and only 1 pound of fat. It seems that potatoes are not very fattening, the starch being the principal food value. As a food the "spud" would be costly and but little used were it not for the immense amount capable of being raised on a small piece of ground, rice being a far superior food.

Yet, withal, the homely old potato has found favor with peasant and king, for the big water bulk, the starch and the little fat enriched by butter make a dish causing more mouths to water than any other dish daily set before over a billion of humanity.

MAKING MANY NEW CITIZENS

Owing to the reservation openings, declarations of intention to become citizens of the United States have so piled up with the clerk of the federal court since July 1 that the supply of blanks for this purpose has been exhausted and all applicants are now referred to the clerk of the superior court.

It costs \$1 to take out "first papers" in the federal court, while the fee is \$1.50 at the county clerk's office. The county clerk must give \$1 of the money he collects to the government and retains the other 50 cents for reimbursing the county for the work of recording the application. For this service Clerk Atkinson says the county comes out loser.

Since July 1 140 foreigners have filed their declarations with the clerk of the federal court and 14 with the clerk of the superior court. The nationalities represented in the declarations are: Swedish 28, Norwegians 20, Canadians 14, Germans 13, English 15, Hungarians 10, Danes 9, Russians 9, Scots 5, Irish 5, Austrians 4, Swiss 4, Americans 3, Italians 2, Dutch 3, Bulgarians 2, Turks 2, Montenegrans 2, Welsh 1, Roumanians 1, French 1, Greeks 1.
