### THREE YEAR OLD LAD BADLY SCALDED WHILE PLAYING IN KITCHEN

SON OF MR. AND MRS. BOONE OF HERMISTON MEETS PAINFUL ACCIDENT.

Child Jars Stopper From Washing Machine and Hot Water Covers His Limbs Inflicting Severe Burns—Physicians Think Little One Will Recover Nicely. (Special Correspondence.) HERMISTON, Ore., April 14.—Feyton, Jr., the 3 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. P. T. Boone was badly scalded by hot water from the washing machine Monday morning. The child who was playing in the kitchen where the weekly washing was in progress accidentally jarred the stopper of the washing machine, the hot water coming with great force covered the child's limbs and abdomen. A physician was summoned and found the burns to be only of the second degree and it is thought no permanent injury will result.

### INVESTIGATION MADE INTO COPPER STRIKE

CHICAGO, April 15.—Michigan's labor war in the copper mine district was recounted today to the Industrial Relations Commission. Union leaders and operators of the copper mines today told of the causes, violence and results of the strike, at the closing session of an eight-day hearing held by the commission. It has investigated labor conditions of the stock yards, the Pullman, Illinois Central and Harriman strikes and the telegrapher's disputes.

### Panoramic View of Oregon Solons

(By B. F. Swagart.)

The Jack Jenet and mule industries are fields of activity of great importance to the development of the resources of Oregon, and capable under favorable legislative enactments, of great development. In order to make the most of these industries, we must have favorable laws thereunto, so that we that are engaged in stockraising of this class can compete with the corresponding stockraisers of other states where good statute law concerning these industries obtain.

The acclimated Oregon-bred jack, although superior in constitution, conformity, vitality, longevity, endurance and symmetry of body and limbs, to the jack raised in the east and to that of the south, is now classed as "mongrel" bred—a perversion of a fact which is incompatible with the truth.

The Standard Jack and Jenet Registry of American Incorporated under the laws of the State of Missouri by the Association of Jack and Jenet Breeders of America, in which my jacks and jennets are registered, is the largest and best in the world, and yet not recognized by our legislature, and therefore compels me to license my stock as "mongrel bred."

Having requested both our state senator and representative to use their influence in passing a more favorable law as to the Jack and Jenet registry, we received the following reply: "By tacit agreement we cannot pass any more bills." And though we have made several previous attempts to induce our solons to so modify the present registry law as to be of assistance to this industry, they have always turned a deaf ear to our appeals, stouly ignoring that which is of paramount importance to this class of stockraisers in Oregon.

The last legislature made many blunders that the supreme court has been kept busy to modify and correct the measures. If it were only possible to instill into the minds of our solons that one assembly is not to outdo the preceding one in the number of bills presented. Quality, not quantity, should be considered. It is hardly conceivable that a thousand bills were clamoring for recognition, awaiting the moulding of legislative enactment. Because the less ink and paper is wasted in printing useless bills, the better pleased will be the people of the Webfoot state.

According to the report of the secretary of state, the apportionment expenditure for the years 1915, 1916, will be nine million dollars, six millions of which must be raised by taxation. It seems to be by one million dollars greater than that which was spent the preceding biennial period. The tax rate must be increased if the legislative assembly grants all the requests made upon it by the various state departments. It is hardly necessary to say that state, municipal and county governments should cooperate with the one collective view, that is to economize in all public affairs, and to temper all their enactments by the economies of justice.

By a small majority of approximately 150 votes, the measure abolishing capital punishment in Oregon was carried last November. The ambiguity of the wording of this law, with its theoretical bombast and pat-taceous vacuity, caused confusion and uncertainty as to the punishment of criminals of first degree murder. And to prevent such persons to go free, the governor commuted their sentence into life imprisonment after the result of the November election was known. Then there was confusion as to the time when an initiative measure should go into effect. The assembly of 1913 passed approximately 100 bills, with few exceptions, the twenty-eighth legislative assembly has no constructive legislation and though it has been credited with 400 measures, only a few are good, others detrimental to the welfare of the people, still others in discord with the constitution. law vary in importance from a very insignificant one to an amendment of the constitution giving the governor power to veto single items in appropriation bills. Following the practice of its not very worthy predecessors the last legislature, before closing, provided for the holding of a special election next November upon the prohibition measure which is a subject to the referendum. Such elections cost the state approximately \$100,000, which greatly increases the burden of the already over-burdened taxpayer. The need of having effective legislation for the enactment of the prohibition measure after January, 1916, and the fear that the act passed at the last session would be subject to the referendum, caused them to choose the special election; yet its alternative, a special session would have been far less expensive to the state. As a general rule voters are less interested in measures than in men, and do not turn out en masse at the special election as they do at the regular election. And as a consequence, a minority of the electorate would likely decide the fate of the prohibition measure and such other measures as would come up for decision by the collective vote of the people.

Some years ago our tax law provided for the payment of taxes in April, or one-half in April and the other half in September. After it had been modified so as to make the taxpayer remit all of his or her taxes in April, and an increasingly monthly interest and a fine was added by our pedantic and ostentatious lawmakers. Since then the law has been changed again.

In retrospect of the above statement would it not be advisable to confer the functions of the legislature to the supreme court, which, by the way, must pass upon many laws created by the solons. Some are unconstitutional, others are in discord with other laws, others are ambiguous as to phraseology of the measures, and having a destructive rather than constructive tendency. Economics of justice should always prevail. It means a reconstruction in laws, improved method of procedure and opinions cleansed from dross of selfishness, greed and graft.

Persons who have attained moral stamina will come to the front from the rank and file of the people. It is time for us to take new and living symbols; and tear the bandage from the eyes of justice. To discover the wolf masquerading in sheep's clothing. We must see the scales of justice do balance; that the ballast of evidence is right opinions and not flimsy expression, precedent and pragmatic technicality.

As class consciousness reigns now supreme on the mundane sphere of activity, there is no equality today in the value of man. Abe Lincoln the illustrious statesman of yore whose earthly pilgrimage was so characteristic of purity, humility, selfless love and impersonal love, and whose pure deeds of love are immortalized upon the scroll of heaven, lived up to his motto: Charity for all; enmity to none.

Does our standard of conduct and meting out justice compare favorably with that of the sainted statesman, now sojourning in Realms of Light? To man alone of all the creatures in the infinite domain of nature's vast laboratory, is given the power to create his own character. His power is the sum total of his powers or faculties in action. The all-wise Creator bestowed upon him the light of reason and the transcendental faculty of intuition to direct his activity either for constructive or destructive purpose. After all, in the last analysis, the results remain with the individual, whether preacher, banker, judge, lawmaker, printer or manual laborer, because the collective standard of our state is conditioned by the individual units that compose it.

Justice is an attribute of the Infinite. A power given to man to transmute discord into harmony; corruption into purity; suburban insular into initiative perception; parochial egotism into self-less and impersonal love, so characteristic of the gentle Nazarene whose earthly pilgrimage was a constant radiation of purity, humility and impersonal love the mystic solvent of all human shortcomings.

Only through the economic of justice, although imperfectly manifested in and applied to human needs, shall we solve our problems by the medium of the alchemy of impersonal love. Thus, and thus only, shall we be triumphant in attaining our standard in the economics of justice promulgated to us by the omnipresent, omniscient and omnipotent Creator of the infinite universe.
