PLEASING RECREATION FOR RURAL COMMUNITY

Miss Havenhill of British Columbia, in her lecture on "Recreation for the rural community," given at the Farmers' Week Conference at Oregon Agricultural College, mentioned the success attending the introduction of folk dancing into a number of rural community entertainments.

Her lectures aroused so much interest in women from rural communities that a large number of requests for the names of books containing the forms and music for the folk dancing of various countries, has come in, and below is a list of books which Miss Havenhill particularly recommends. These are arranged in the order of simplicity and definiteness of directions.

The folk dancing of the different countries is not at all like our modern dancing, but is the form of dancing practiced in these countries for many generations. It is more like a series of very interesting and athletic exercises. Many of them are in many cases, beautiful rhythmic much like the singing games of our own childhood which were really folk dances. When given in costume they form a very interesting feature of entertainment. The books mentioned below can doubtless be borrowed from the Oregon state library which lends books to any one in the state upon application and payment of postage. The Oregon state library has a large collection of books on folk dancing so that if the particular books mentioned in this list should not be in doubtless others can be secured which will give the desired directions and music.

SWEDEN IS READY TO ENTER EUROPEAN WAR

WASHINGTON, Jan. 25.—Sweden may join the list of smaller nations fighting on the side of the central empires within a week, according to information which reached Senator Albert B. Fall of New Mexico Sunday through private sources. Declaration of war will be made upon Great Britain and upon Russia, Senator Fall's advisers state. Actual hostilities, it is understood, will be begun with an attack on Russia through Finland.

"The real reason for Sweden's declaring war," said Senator Fall, "will be found in the repeated efforts of Great Britain to force Sweden to do this very thing. However, great bitterness against Russia may be found in Sweden, recent developments in the British blockade of Sweden have aroused the Swedes to an even more bitter hostility against England. From the outbreak of the war Sweden has been actively favorable to Germany and has done everything in her power to aid Germany."

"My information that war is imminent comes from a reliable source and all the facts seem to make it more than probable."

Fowler Charges Bribery

WASHINGTON, Jan. 25.—Representative Fowler charged that "more than dollar bills" were offered to gain inducements in anti-ally activities in the labor peace council. This statement was made during a hearing when Fowler opposed extradition to New York.

He attacked the indictments on the grounds they failed to state the offense against the United States. He declared that information be adduced concerning the prosecution would startle even the birds in the woods. He said unfortunately he could not present the charges fully before Commissioner Taylor.

President Mohler Will Recover.
OMAHA, Jan. 25.—President Mohler of the Union Pacific, regained consciousness this morning after 24 hours insensibility, following a fall on the ice Sunday. He will recover.
