To Drainage Contractors:  
The contract for the construction of the Lick Creek Drainage Canal will be let to the lowest responsible bidder, at the Court House in Selmer, Tenn., on Monday, Feb. 1, 1914, at noon.

The canal is to be on Lick Creek in the Counties of Hardin and McNairy, State of Tennessee, is about 8.54 miles long, with an average depth of 5.35 feet and an average width of bottom of 18.5 feet. The estimated earth to be removed is 175,000 yards. The right of way to be cleared is about 34 acres.

The work is to be begun not later than May 1, 1914, and completed by September 1, 1914, the contract and work to be done all under the Drainage Laws of Tennessee, and especially under the Act of the General Assembly of 1909, Chapter 185.

The work lies, at its nearest point, about 12 miles from Corinth, Miss., and is reached over the Turn-pike from Corinth.

Bids will be received on the entire work both the clearing of the right of way and the canal proper all in one bid; also bids will be received for the clearing of the right-of-way and for the construction of the canal separately; the right is reserved to reject any and all bids.
