GOVERNMENT TO BUY LAND HERE

Will Take Over a Tract of Cocke County Timber for a Watershed.


The United States government is planning to purchase some Cocke county land for the purpose of turning the land into a watershed. The land will be located in the Smoky mountains, and just what tract will be secured has not been decided upon. The government will not pay exorbitant prices for any land, and the plan to buy Cocke county property is but an item in a general effort to buy up watershed property.

Both large and small tracts of land, especially in the Appalachian and White mountain regions, will be considered for purchase by the United States to be turned into watersheds. Lands held out to obtain exorbitant prices will not be considered.

Where lands contain timber, the government will purchase both the land and the timber, or with timber reserved to the owner and other classes of lands wanted are cut over or culled lanes, brush and burned lands not

We call special attention to the Eastman Plate Tank. It consists of a metal solution cup with tightly fitting cover, a cage for holding twelve plates or less, during development and fixing and an ingenious loading block for loading the plates into the cage in the dark room. The exposed plates are loaded into the cage and placed in the tank in the dark room, and the tank cover fastened in place. On the front of the tank is a dial for registering time. Development is allowed to continue for 15 minutes, the tank being reversed several times. After development the developer is washed out of the plates and the fixing bath poured into the tank, after which the plates are ready for washing in the usual manner.

The contractors are taking hold of the work vigorously and, we are glad to say, "are doing things," and we confidently expect to have the work all completed within the contract time.
"Since, last report, we have spent \$7,907.50 on all the roads and cost of administration, leaving \$132,877.35 not counting the 10% retained on the McCrary contract.
"We have accomplished more during the last month than in any month during the road construction, and we are well pleased with the prospects.
