Little Corn On Farm

The report of G. L. Morris, field agent, bureau of crop estimates, which was recently issued, shows that the amount of corn on Tennessee Farms at this time is very much below the amount held at the same time last year. This is accounted for in that a much shorter crop was grown coupled with heavy losses along many streams. Many sections suffered from drouth; much corn was late due to a backward planting season and was damaged in the fall by wet weather. The report shows that the amount of corn shipped out of the counties where grown is far below the usual, only nine per-cent being shipped.

The amount of wheat on the farms is about as usual. The great bulk of the oat crop in the state was used as hay.

The report also states that there has been an increase of 25 per cent in farm land values of all kinds in the past twelve months, and many farms have changed hands at prices that would seem far in excess of their productive capacity.

TENNESSEE CORN CLUB BOYS AVERAGE 54.4 BUSHELS COSTING 46c

Last year the corn club boys of Tennessee produced an average of 54.5 bushels of corn per acre. If it is valued at \$1.50 per bushel, the crop from each acre was worth \$81.45.

Each boy kept an account of the cost of growing his corn, which averaged \$25.07 per acre. When we deduct this from the value of the crop, there remains a net profit of \$56.38.

In order to give an idea as to the methods followed by some of the more successful corn club boys in growing their corn, a few of their records will be printed during this season. It is hoped that their methods will be a source of information to others who will be able to produce equally good results. Until we apply on a large scale the most practical methods used by successful farmers and corn club boys, we will not reap the full benefit of the great work the county agents are doing.
