English Turnip Culture. Of late years the water drill has been employed with great advantage for sowing turnip seed. The mode of working these drills is far less difficult than would generally be conceived.

Not only does the water drill sow in the drills (mixed with the artificial manure) along with the seed moisten the seed bed, and hasten the braiding of the crop, but it is the best possible means of conveying the food of the young plants to the soil.
