## STATE OF MARYLAND, Treasury Department, COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE, ANNAPOLIS, October 1st, 1875.

In compliance with Sec. 6, Art. 69, Code Public General Laws, to wit:—  
"The Comptroller shall furnish each officer of the State whose accounts are in arrears, at least thirty days prior to a general election, a full statement of his accounts, and in default of his accounting for such deficiencies within thirty days, then it shall be the duty of the Comptroller to have published, weekly, for one month, in one or more newspapers in the several counties of the State, and in the city of Baltimore, the names and titles of said officers, with the amount of such deficiencies."  
I herewith publish the following list which embraces the names of accounting officers in arrears to the State of Maryland, together with the amount of principal and interest due by each, as of September 30th, 1875.
