in the several Election Districts of said county, as follows, viz: First District.....Port Tobacco Second District.....Hill Top Third District.....Cross Roads Fourth District.....Allens' Fresh Fifth District.....Harris' Lot Sixth District.....Middletown Seventh District.....Pomonkey Eighth District.....Bryantown Ninth District.....Patuxent City

One person to be Comptroller of the Treasury of the State of Maryland; One person to be Chief Judge and one person to be Associate Judge for the Seventh Judicial District; One person to represent Charles county in the Senate of the State of Maryland; Three persons to represent Charles county in the House of Delegates of the State of Maryland; One person to be Sheriff of Charles county; Five persons to be County Commissioners of Charles county; One person to be County Surveyor of Charles county.

Voters will also cast their ballots "For the Constitutional Amendment," or "Against the Constitutional Amendment," in accordance with an Act of the General Assembly, passed at January Session, 1880, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State.

The polls for said Election will be opened in each and every Election District of said county, at the usual places of holding the polls, at 9 o'clock A. M., and will close at 6 o'clock P. M., when the ballots shall be opened and publicly counted.

NOTICE. To Hotel Keepers and Others who Deal in Liquors.

FOR THE INFORMATION OF ALL PERSONS CONCERNED, the following Act of the Legislature, passed March 24th, 1865, is published: CHAPTER 191. AN ACT prohibiting the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors in the several counties of the State on the day of election.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall not be lawful for the keeper of any hotel, tavern, store, drinking establishment, or any other place where liquors are sold, or for any person or persons, directly or indirectly, to sell, barter, give, or dispose of any spirituous or fermented liquors, ale, beer, or intoxicating drinks of any kind, on the day of election hereafter to be held in the several counties of this State.

SECTION 2. And be it enacted, That any person violating the provisions of this Act shall be liable to indictment by the Grand Jury of the county where the offence is committed, and shall, upon conviction before any Judge of any of the Circuit Courts of this State, be fined a sum not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each and every offence.

SECTION 3. And be it enacted, That any person offending against the preceding section, shall be liable to indictment in the Circuit Court, if the offence is committed in any county, or in the Criminal Court of Baltimore, and on conviction, shall be fined not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dollars, to be paid to the State for the use of the School fund.

SECTION 4. Every deposit of money in any part of the State, as a wager or bet upon elections in this State or elsewhere, shall be forfeited and paid over to the County Commissioners of the county where deposited for the use of the county; and if deposited in the City of Baltimore, to the Mayor and City Council.
