We entertain the hope that when this beneficent feature of the existing law is understood, which does not seem to be the case, that the able editors will appear in the Legislature any further censure and will permit the tax which has existed for more than a century, which turns \$27,000 annually into the treasury and about which no complaint has been in all that time heard in the State, to remain as it is, to be paid by such happy people as will cheerfully do so; and not insist upon the revenues of the State being unnecessarily reduced to such an extent at a time when every effort of forced economy is being resorted to in order to rehabilitate our sinking funds and improve the financial condition of the State.

The Legislature. The Senate adjourned till Tuesday morning and the House of Delegates till Monday night. Bills were introduced in the Senate to impose an additional license on the sale of spirits and fermented liquors and to regulate the landing at the State tobacco warehouses of boats laden with fruits and vegetables.

The House of Delegates of Maryland met last night. The employment of additional engraving clerks was authorized. A bill was introduced for the purpose of effecting compromise settlements with delinquent State officers.

In the Senate the bill enabling the city of Baltimore to loan \$2,000,000 for securing Southern connections by the Richmond and Danville Railroad was reported favorably and passed to the third reading.

In the House of Delegates the bill to abolish action for distress for rent and to substitute summary ejectment instead was reported unfavorably and the report adopted.

The Senate adopted a resolution to investigate the Mayor's conduct, but subsequently a motion to reconsider went over till Thursday. Bills were passed and sent to the House reducing marriage licenses to 60 cents and admitting colored lawyers to practice in the State courts.

In the House of Delegates the bill to establish the Maryland Agricultural Experiment Station at Pikesville to reduce the pay of judges in Baltimore city courts to give the mayor and city council control of wharf building in Baltimore. The Senate bill was passed amending the charter of Hagers town; also House bill making the working time for Allegheny miners ten hours a day. The bill to extend the limits of Baltimore city was amended in committee and reported favorably.

The Supreme Court of the United States on Monday, in the case of Juillard vs. Greenman, decided that the legal tender act of May 31, 1875, is valid and constitutional, and that treasury notes reissued under it are a good and legal tender in payment of debts.

This session, however, the measure has been pushed with greater vim, the great moral aspect of it has been developed and a singular change seems to have come over the spirit of the friends of our esteemed luminary. It is now said that it is grievously wrong for the State to discourage matrimony by imposing a tax thereon, and it is argued that many of the poorer classes and especially the colored population are prevented from entering the holy estate by this unholy tax and are encouraged to cultivate immoral relations between the sexes.

It seems to us that all the arguments in support of the measure have been based upon the false major premise that, under the existing law, the obtaining of license is made a necessary condition precedent to being lawfully married. Such is not the case. The existing law provides that "no person within this State shall marry without a license, or before the names of the parties intending to marry shall be three published in some church or house of religious worship, in the county where the woman resides, on three several Sundays, by some minister residing in said county."
