RINGWORM IN CALVES

This is a skin disease that appears most frequently during the late winter and early spring. Its presence is shown by the appearance of scabby areas that vary from half the size of a penny to that of a dollar, and even larger. The hair falls out and the surface of the scabby area is covered with a fine white scurf. It shows oftenest about the calves heads and necks, but may also appear on any part of the body. Ring worm is caused by a small parasite that burrows in the skin. Its contagious nature is well demonstrated by the fact that the diseased animals spread it by rubbing against others that are healthy. The fact that heads and necks come in frequent and close contact while the calves are pushing and crowding about the managers explains why the disease appears oftenest on these parts. Treatment is simple and effective, requiring but a short time for complete cure in all ordinary cases. Tincture of iodine applied to the scabs with a suitable brush or swab several times, at intervals of several days, is all that is required. When the disease encircles the eyes, care must be taken to avoid getting the medicine into them.—Dr. C. C. Lipp, University Farm, St. Paul.
