KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we have agreed to, and do hereby associate ourselves together as a Banking Corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Laws of the State of Minnesota governing Banks of Discount and Deposit; and to do and we do hereby execute, under our hands and seals the following Certificate of Incorporation, to-wit:
