From the Pioneer Press. **REPUBLICANISM IN THE SOUTH.**
An address of suggestive interest has been prepared by Albert Griffin and is sent out from Washington. Its subject is "The Upper South: Its Republican Probabilities and Possibilities." It deals with political indications in certain of the Southern states as deduced from the statistics of the last decade. Mr. Griffin divides what we call the Southern states into two sections: The Upper South, including those which are nearest to the Northern and Middle states, and those whose inhabitants are more nearly akin in temperament and habits to the people of the North; the Lower South, including the Gulf states and South Carolina and Arkansas, making the thirty-fifth parallel about the line of division. It is stated at the outset that in the latter division no advance has been made by the Republican party for years; nor is there present hope for making any. In the Upper South, however, the Republicans are organized and have made constant gains over the Democrats for the last twelve years. This is satisfactorily demonstrated by tables showing the votes by counties in the eight states for the four presidential years, 1876, 1880, 1884 and 1888. The point which is made by careful examination of each of these tables is that the Republican gain has, in every case, been largest in the states having the least proportion of negro population, and in those states it has been largest in the counties where negroes are fewest.

In Maryland, gains have been made in every county. The total Republican gain for the twelve years has been almost twice that of the Democrats. "Maryland," Mr. Griffin says, "was never a black state, and is constantly growing whiter." The Republicans began in 1876 with one-sixth of the counties, and now control one-half of them. In Delaware alone, of all the states in the Union, the Republicans made decided gains last year. Here also the blacks are in small proportion. In West Virginia still more rapid progress has been made; in 1876 the Republicans had, in 11 counties, an average majority of 304, which was increased in 1888 to 474 in 24 counties. The net Republican gain has been 1,158 per year. As to press support, the Republicans are more favored here than in any other Southern state, for it contains almost as many Republican as Democratic papers. The whites are increasing eighteen times as rapidly as are the blacks, yet here, as elsewhere, the race cry is vigorously raised by the Democrats. In Virginia 55 out of the 100 counties returned a majority for Harrison. Cleveland's majority was only 1,539 out of a total vote of 302,415, in 1876 a majority of 44,112 out of 235,228 was won by the Democrats. The same story is told by a glance at the statistics of North Carolina, Tennessee, Kentucky, and Arkansas, and in every case the increase in the Republican vote tallies with the decrease in colored population.

From these facts Mr. Griffin concludes that the outlook in the South is encouraging for several reasons. He believes that of these eight states, six may be gained for the Republicans next year, provided the members of that party do their duty. The responsibility lies most heavily of course upon local workers, but the North can do much in the way of encouragement. Mr. Griffin points out the fact that while party losses were heavy last year, they were heaviest in the North. The election laws in the Lower South are an obstacle to Republican gains, but in the other states they are favorable except in the lack of precautions against fraud. He finds a remedy for the defects in election legislation in the entire separation of state from federal elections.

Among the reasons suggested why the Republicans have been so much greater in the Upper than in the Lower South, is the fact that the people of the Upper Southern states are more nearly allied to the North in temperament, mentally, morally and physically. They are more thoughtful, industrious and thrifty, than the inhabitants of the far South. Slavery was less prevalent among them than in the lower states, and the proportion of negroes to the total population is smaller. The relation of this latter fact to the greater Republican strength is not obvious to any one who has not made a study of the conditions. It lies in the fact that wherever there is a large proportion of negroes, the race question is made a campaign topic by the Democrats, who set up negro domination as a probable contingency of Republican success. Where the blacks are fewer, it is less easy to arouse the white voter and he, as well as the negro, are more likely to vote freely and fairly. So that what would appear, on the surface, to be an advantage to the Republican party, since the blacks owe their freedom to the principles that it represents, becomes, through Democratic fraud an intimidating, a hampering condition.

Articles of Incorporation
LITTLE FALLS BUILDING & LOAN ASSOCIATION.

The undersigned, in order to become a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of Minnesota, in such case made and provided, have adopted and signed the following Articles of Incorporation.

The name of the corporation shall be the "Little Falls Building and Loan Association," to be located in the City of Little Falls, County of Morrison, State of Minnesota, and no business shall be conducted outside of said County of Morrison.

The general nature of the business of this corporation shall be the accumulation of funds in money, to be loaned to its members, and the loaning of such funds on real estate and other securities approved by the directors, and the receiving of deposits from its members, to be used in buying, building and improving their homes and other investments authorized by law and satisfactory to the directors, also the doing of any business naturally appertaining to the principal objects aforesaid, but now for no other purpose than the carrying on of similar character in this state. All said business to be done on the Mutual Plan.

Said corporation shall begin on the 30th day of October, A. D. 1911, and continue for the period of thirty (30) years thereafter.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be Five Hundred Thousand Dollars, divided into 50,000 shares of ten Dollars each. The same shall be paid in full in money, to wit: One-fifth of the full value of each share at the time of its subscription, and the balance of four-fifths of the full value of each share at such times and under such conditions as the board of directors may determine.

Sec. 2. The directors shall be elected by the members of the association, and shall hold office for one year, and until their successors are elected and qualified.
