

It was improper to talk about these people as mysterious, for they were no more mysterious than the Shawnees, the Natchez, the Tensas, and other tribes. The cloth found in their works was like that made by every tribe from the lakes to the gulf, even less fine than some, and their pottery was no better. In short, the speaker said, in his opinion the mound-builders were the ancestors of the Indians .- Popular Science Monthly.

A new method of mutilating silver currency is being employed by num-bers of patent-medicine venders and others to advertise their goods and wares. Of late large numbers of coins have been received in the treasury which are stamped on one side with advertisements. The stamps used are some sort of die which cuts letters and words into the coin. In most instances the name of the owner of the article advertised is not cut on the coin, but the advertisement simply recommends a certain nostrum or article. As the coin is stamped only on one side, it can be passed very readily, exposing only the perfect side. This is a mutilation of the currency and a violation of the law. 




