Who Were the Mound Builders.

Dr. W. De Haas, after a careful examination of the mound-builders, and the ancient races of Mexico, has come to the conclusion that it does not exist. He considers that the former people were but little advanced beyond the modern Indians, but that they were different. In the discussion that followed the reading of Dr. De Haas' paper in the association, Judge Henderson objected to the term "mound-builders" as one that conveyed a false idea. There is no evidence, he said, which will justify us in separating the ancient and modern races, not a single feature peculiar to the so-called mound-builders. The speaker had started out in the study of American archeology with the impression that these people were distinct and separate from the Indians, but he had been compelled by the force of facts to relinquish the theory. He was an inquirer, and he considered these people as mysterious, for they were no more mysterious than the Shawnees, the Natchez, the Tonas, and other tribes. The cloth found in their mounds was like that made by every tribe from the lakes to the gulf, even less fine than some, and their pottery was no better. In short, the speaker said, in his opinion the mound-builders were the ancestors of the Indians. —Popular Science Monthly.

A new method of mutilating silver currency is being employed by numbers of patent-medicine vendors and
