COACHES PICK ALL-TIME ALL-AMERICAN TEAM

The current number of "Leslie's" gives the answers of four famous wizards of the gridiron to the question: "Who are the biggest stars who ever hoisted a hall?"

The four experts are Fielding H. Yost, who played on the Lafayette team of 1896, and who for twenty years has been coaching Michigan; Glen S. Warner, who gained fame at both Carleton and Pittsburgh as a winning coach; John H. Heisman, who began coaching twenty-six years ago, and today has charge of the Pennsylvania State team; and "Big Bill" Edwards, the old Princeton star.

Thirty-one players from thirteen universities secured votes for the All-Time All-American Team. Jim Thorpe, who played with the Carlisle Indian eleven from 1908 to 1912, was the only man that got the vote of each of the voters. Six players were picked from Yale, five from Princeton; Harvard and Carleton each had three; Michigan, West Point, Pittsburgh, W. and L. and Colgate were credited with two each; and one man was picked from Pennsylvania, Chicago, Minnesota and Williams.

The All-Time All-American team as picked by these men would be: four votes—Thorpe—Carlisle, half-back, four votes—Shelton—Yale, end, three votes—Hefelfinger—Yale, guard, three votes—Hart—Pennsylvania, guard, three votes—Schubert—Michigan, center, two votes—Eversall—Chicago, quarter-back, two votes—Hoson—Michigan, half-back, two votes—Mahan—Harvard, full-back, two votes.

The wizards of the gridiron could not agree on a tackle or on the man who would take care of the other end.

TRAVIS TO PLAY IN AGGIE GAME

If there was ever any over-confidence on the part of the football team it is gone now. Conscientious work marks the attitude of the men as they go through the daily grind. While the Kansas Aggie game is not looked upon as a hard battle, due to the poor showing the Aggies have made this season, the coaches do not expect a walkover by any means. The strongest lineup possible will be sent in at the start and its mission will be to tack the game safely in the win column during the first quarter.

The entire second varsity team started the scrimmage with the freshmen last night. The regulars were sent in one by one until at the close of the practice the yearlings were faced by the first string men.

Travis was again on the sidelines. The ill-timed tackle received injuries in the back during the Oklahoma game that have kept him out of the scrimmages this week. He will be in shape to start the game Saturday. The Tarkio boy played a sensational game last season and earned the right to be called the best tackle in the Missouri Valley Conference; but with his splendid physical condition and conscientious training it is not difficult to predict he will wind up this season playing a better brand of football than he did the last. Travis is the brains of the Tarkio line. His natural instinct in following the ball, the manner in which he recovers fumbles and handles open plays, stamp him as a tackle whose services are invaluable to the Tigers.
