FOR CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.

After due consideration Judge J. S. Gossom of Caruthersville has this week decided to enter the race for Circuit Court Judge of this, the 38th judicial circuit, composed of New Madrid and Pemiscot counties.

Needless to say that Judge Gossom is running on the Democratic ticket subject to the will of the voters in the August primary. While this office is, or should be, non-political, it is nevertheless necessary for candidates to have party affiliation; but after being elected and on the bench politics should be left behind, as would be the case should Judge Gossom be successful in the contest. He is broad-minded enough to do that, and if elected, neither politics nor religion, nor influence, nor favor, nor fear, would govern in the slightest degree his meting out the code of justice to the high, the low, the rich and the poor, all alike.

That sort of administration of judicial justice is a suffering need in this little spot of the world, and the election of Judge Gossom would constitute a warranty that this should not fail, or in any instance be denied.

Judge Gossom is not a new man to our people. He has been tried. There is no experiment to be made in trusting him. For six years he served this county as Prosecuting Attorney, being elected for three terms consecutively. Perhaps at no other period in the history of Pemiscot county was there so much work performed by the Prosecuting Attorney's office, and never against greater odds, for Judge Gossom's ability made him the envy of a certain combination that threw not a few stumbling blocks in his path whenever they could, which was often enough. But he rose superior and above all that, and fought the harder to maintain the right, which he generally did. Always he was equal to the occasion, no matter how big his opponent towered, and the times were few and far between when he came out of the fight second best. He always upheld the State's side of the case with admirable ability. He was vigorous, relentless and determined, and if ever he gave up, it was in the last ditch, after his legal ammunition was exhausted.

Judge Gossom has now reached the golden age of life when man is at his best. He has had the experience and knows the law. In asking to be elected he has but one aim—and that is to fill the office and faithfully and impartially serve the people, and thereby win for himself honorable credit, so much to be desired as the goal of life.

Judge Gossom has a fine judicial mind, fair, keen, kind, yet firm and unyielding. Coupled with this he knows the law and has the courage to stand for its proper enforcement.

POORHOUSE AND JAIL IN POOR CONDITION.

An Associated Press Dispatch from Jefferson City, under date of May 24, says:

"Abandonment of the almshouse in Pemiscot county and the building of either a new county home or provisions for the care of inmates through some other means, are the recommendations contained in a letter to the court of Pemiscot county made public today at the offices of the State board of charities and corrections here.

"The Pemiscot county almshouse is an old ten-room building, in bad repair, the board finds, with no modern facilities for bathing, and almost no furniture or equipment.

Bunks are badly needed for the prisoners in the Pemiscot county jail. W. L. Miller, inspector for the board, reports. He says he found five men and one woman sleeping on the floor of the jail during his recent inspection.

"Bathing facilities for the prisoners are urgently needed, the letter to the county court said.

"Inspector Miller returned several days ago from an inspection tour of several counties in Southeast Missouri and recommendations for the Pemiscot county institution are said to be most urgent."
