AT HARVARD MONEY IS WASTED

REPUBLICAN POLICY COSTING TAXPAYERS MILLIONS.

Congressional Committee on Naval Affairs Refuse to Take Advice of Experts—Squander Public Cash on Obsolete Armament.

The question of building more battleships is again under discussion in congress and President Roosevelt in his letter to the chairman of the house committee on naval affairs urges the construction of "battleships of large displacement with their primary batteries all of one type of big guns."

As the battleships at present in commission will all be comparatively worthless in a few years, it is most important that such new ships as congress may provide for shall be of the most modern type and able to move than cope with anything afloat. The size of the battleship is not the only thing to be considered, for it is acknowledged that a battleship of the Dreadnaught type would be at the mercy of a smaller ship with greater speed and armed with guns of greater size and power than the present 12-inch guns.

Four 14 or 16-inch guns mounted on a vessel of much less displacement than the Dreadnaught could stand out of the range of her fire and destroy her, or even a ship with two such guns could better the Dreadnaught on the ancient plan of the bow and stern chasers with which the privates of the war of 1812 were armed, which established them to stand off a broadside of a ship of greater power and a much greater broadside of lighter guns.

It requires no argument to prove that a battleship of 16,000 tons, carrying four 16-inch guns and having a speed of 20 knots, would have a 20,000-ton Dreadnaught at her mercy, although the latter has ten 12-inch guns in her broadside. The faster ship will always be able to select the distance which she will fight at and would naturally choose to be where her antagonist could do her the least harm.

The ship with 12-inch armor is now comparatively safe outside of the range of torpedoes, whose radius is from 3,000 to 5,000 yards, because the present 12-inch naval gun is unable to pierce 12-inch armor at that distance, but a smaller battleship with larger guns and with the necessary speed might inflict such damage as to lead to her sinking.

It would seem to be waste of money for Uncle Sam to continue to build battleships of the same size and with the same armament as the battleships that other nations have already constructed, for with the constant evolution in size and speed and greater armament, such ships are comparatively worthless before they have a chance to ever go into action.

It is demonstrated that guns of 14 or 16-inch will weigh but little more than the present 12-inch naval gun, and it is not necessary to use such enormous powder charges, yet the range of these larger guns is superior to the 12-inch type. The construction of these larger guns is urged by the chief of ordnance of the army, and his recommendation is based upon a long series of experiments, so his conclusions must be accepted as correct.

As it is now, we are following in the wake of England and are throwing away millions of dollars every year on ships and armament that have already proved to be of an obsolete type, and yet our political Republican politicians seem determined to perpetuate a type of ships and guns which will be turned over to the junk heap.

They persist in providing for shells that experience proves will not penetrate the armor of a battleship at the distance that the known range of torpedoes compels the commander of a battleship to place his vessel at, notwithstanding that experiments have proved that shells which explode on contact are available, and the present shells in use are comparatively worthless.

The committee of the house and senate on naval affairs must wake up and learn their lesson and not continue in a rut that will bring disaster if we shall be so unfortunate as to engage in a war with a first-class naval power. Uncle Sam must have the best of the most modern ships, guns and projectiles that the ingenuity of our inventors is offering, and the expense of experimenting with the new ideas offered is but a small matter compared to the millions we are annually expending that are wasted.

Republicans and the Negro. The president's plan to get even with Senator Foraker by appointing a negro surveyor of customs at Cincinnati met with such protests from the Republican leaders that he is said to have abandoned the idea. How the Republican politicians love the negro when he is voting "early and often," but when it comes to rewarding him for his partisan support of the G. O. P. it is a horse of another color, and a white one at that.

Free Trade Zones. The strange economic theories of Secretary Shaw will soon be of much consequence, for after March 4 he will sink into political disrepute. But as showing the perplexed condition of the standpoint mind in seeking to escape the inevitable tariff reform, his proposition to create three free trade zones, two of which are to be located on the Atlantic coast and one on the gulf coast, where manufacturing may be established and allowed to use free raw material for products to be sold abroad, is remarkable. These free trade zones would be for the advantage of foreigners, so that American products could be sold to them cheaper than to our own people, for the full tariff rate would be paid by the American consumer, while manufacturers in the zones or elsewhere.

Carnegie's Hero Fund. Andrew Carnegie's "hero fund" was established in 1904 with \$5,000,000 as its disposal. The commission has awarded 63 medals up to January 1, 1907, and disbursed about \$40,000 out of about \$45,000 given to San Francisco and other sufferers from disasters.

Wood Payments in Cities. The five cities in which the largest amounts of wood payment are found are, in order, Indianapolis, New York, Minneapolis, Toledo and Boston. Together these cities have more crooked wood payment than all other cities in the United States combined. The total amount of the payment in use in this country at the present time in 1905 was about 1,400,000 square yards, equivalent to 1,600,000 cords of payment on a street 20 feet wide.

Received a Sudden Summons. Frederick N. B. Hon. James Bunting Snowball, lieutenant governor of New Brunswick, dropped dead at night in Queen street while on his way to attend service in the cathedral.

Stricken and Died in Church. Philadelphia—James R. McClure, constructing railroad engineer, and secretary and treasurer of the many of the subsidiary companies of the Pennsylvania railroad, was stricken with apoplexy, and died at church.

COLLEGE MEN GLAD Visits Groton School, Where He Tells the Boys That He Learned to Do His Own Fighting.

Cambridge, Mass.—President Roosevelt was the guest of the undergraduates of Harvard, where his son, Theodore, is at school, and took the opportunity to deliver an address in which he set forth their rules of conduct in college and after life.

The president devoted the first part of his address to the undergraduates, advocating athletics, the rougher the better, as a means of developing courage in the man. He glorified the Harvard men by championing football, declaring he could see no reason for its abolition. But he earnestly urged the undergraduates not to become slaves to athletics in any form. Over culture was also held up by the president as something to be shunned.

By this he meant specialization in some particular branch of education which tended in later years to hold the man aloof and apart from his fellows and qualified him for the broader duties of citizenship.

No Sympathy for "Wrongs." Mr. Roosevelt branched off into an attack upon the theorists and idealists, educators and others, who stood apart and superciliously criticized the things that the men who are doing the nation's work are achieving.

In this connection Mr. Roosevelt made a special point of striking at those who clamored for the inviolability of state rights. He declared that though it was laudable to defend state rights, he had no sympathy for the clamor when the defense of state rights included a defense of people's wrongs. As people's wrongs he instanced attempts to prevent the prohibition of child labor and efforts to break the contract labor law for the benefit of foreign states.

At Groton School. The president also visited Groton school, where Kermit, another son, is preparing for college. He was introduced to an audience made up of about 150 students and parents and friends of the pupils. The president gave what he was pleased to call a "short sermon to the boys." Mr. Roosevelt said that when he finished his college course his friends advised him not to enter the curriculum of a preparatory school, but he had told them that he had fully made up his mind to take part in the work of government. He resolved, also, he said, to trouble the world as he could, and not depend on others to do that for him.

He gave a sermon, though a short one," concluded the president, "and now I wish good luck to all of you."

THE COST OF MILK AND CREAM. It Has Increased Enormously in the Last Seven Years.

Washington.—That the cost of milk, and particularly cream, has advanced enormously since 1909, as the result of the curtailment of supply to the factories and the increasing market in the large cities is indicated in a census bulletin issued relative to the manufacture of butter, cheese, condensed milk, flour and grist mill products and starch for 1905. A substantial increase in the manufacture of all these products is shown since 1909, except starch, which declined markedly. Cost of cream increased 247.9 and milk 2.7 per cent.

According to the statement, there were 8,925 establishments engaged in the butter, cheese and condensed milk industry in 1905, with an aggregate capital of \$47,555,566, and employing 15,557 wage-earners, who received \$3,412,937 in wages. With the exception of the number of establishments, all the items show increases since 1909; that is, in value of products amounting to \$37,339,440, representing an increase of 23.8 per cent, or over one-fourth.

LIED IN THE NIGHT TIME. Senator Dooliver's Brother Passed Away While Asleep.

Fort Dodge, Ia.—Victor B. Dooliver, 46 years old, a brother of Senator Dooliver, of Iowa, was found dead here. He was found in his room, lying on the bed as though he had died while asleep. An inquest will be held. Dooliver was known in Iowa as a campaign orator, a business man and a benefactor of Morningstar college of Sioux City.

Report Two Americans Shot. New York.—A private cable dispatch has been received in New York by Minor Bole, representative of the Venezuelan revolutionists, giving details of the execution of two Americans, Gen. Antonio Paredes and 18 of his followers, including his chief of staff, Gen. Juan Badillo, and two Americans. The two Americans who were shot were John Godskin, said to be of Allen-ton, Pa., and Thomas Lovelace, a leading engineer of Maine. Both men had been in Venezuela, it is reported, for some time.

Praise for a Hero. London.—The newspapers here and on the continent are ringing with praise for the heroism of Capt. Spiller, of Dorchester, to whose initiative and command was entirely due the fact that the last three survivors of steamer Berlin, wrecked off the Hook of Holland, were rescued. All the survivors of the Berlin are progressing favorably. They tell affecting stories of their terrible experiences aboard the wreck which, according to salvagers, presented an awful spectacle of destruction.
