THE people of Mexico and Andra are especially interested in the proposition to extend the Mexico, Santa Fe & Perry Railroad. A good strong committee has been appointed to raise subscriptions for this enterprise. We would suggest, before this matter is taken up with the people of Mexico that a grand statement be submitted, showing just what the owners want the people to do and what the owners expect to do after the people have done their part. This is a very important proposition and should be submitted in a business like way. Mexico people are always liberal and fair when called upon for money for public enterprises but it is not reasonable that they should know just what they are to get for their money. A definite proposition might be submitted by the owners of the road which would have the careful and cordial consideration of our people generally.

STATEMENT FROM JUDGE BLEDSOE

In the Mexico Evening Ledger of Friday, the 22nd inst., and also in The Daily Intelligencer of the same date, the County Court was criticized for not appropriating money out of the County revenue to assist in maintaining the County Farm Advisor. As a member of that Court I am willing, and anxious since the adverse criticism to make my position in that matter public.

First: The County Court is not authorized by law to make any such appropriation. Second: The Commercial Club of Mexico, the father of this enterprise, sent out special invitations to each school district in the County to send delegates to meet them at a banquet previous to employing the Farm Advisor for the purpose of molding sentiment favorable to that work, and at that banquet able and strong men but still as you well know, the delegates were almost unanimously opposed to the County Court appropriating a cent from the County revenue but favored raising the money by private subscription, which was the way adopted at that meeting; and later held a meeting in a tent for that purpose.

I think it is very unfair to criticize the County Court for not appropriating money without authority of law and in opposition to the expressed wishes of the taxpayers. Neither do I think we should be classed among the "Knockers" or in opposition to the Farm Advisor, because I have given to this move both moral and financial support, having subscribed \$100.00 for myself and firm which I am a member and I believe the other members of the Court have each done as well.
