Great Lakes, Ill.



**JAMES BLEDSOE,**  
Died Feb. 14, 1918.  
Camp Doniphan, Okla.  
Was the first Audrain boy to die in the service.



**ALEXANDER L. FORD,**  
Killed in action Nov. 1, 1918.  
His body was found on battlefield and buried by Charles Pigg of this city, who knew Ford personally.



**ALBERT R. CREASEY**  
Died October 25, 1918.  
Camp Jackson, S. C.

**ROLLIE V. DUTY**  
Died March 9, 1918.  
Camp Funston, Kans.

**GUY W. SHAW,**  
Killed in action September 28, 1918.

Died at Sea September 30, 1918.

Died July 3, 1918  
Camp Funston, Kans.

**HENRY JOHNSON**  
Only colored soldier from Audrain to die in the war.


