With more than fifty men at work, a big ditching machine on the job, and prospects for good weather for the next three weeks all indications point to the completion of the gas company's mains before the annual freeze comes.

The shortage of labor, several weeks of almost incessant rain, and the subsequent demand for men on threshing rigs has made it difficult to keep the work going, but nothing now stands in the way of starting the plant this fall.
