Republican State Ticket All Elected

carry the state by a plurality over Frank O. Hellstrom and William D. Sweet estimated at 3,500. Figures compiled by the state democratic committee show that Hanna leads Hellstrom by 1,404 with nine counties not reported. As most of these counties are admitted to be Hanna territory that lead will be increased, probably to 3,500.

Not Ready for Statement.
Mr. Hanna last night said his plurality probably will reach 5,000. This estimate is based on figures which have been reported to him. He said he was not ready to make a statement on the outcome of the election but said if he were to make such a statement at this time it would be only in the nature of gratitude to the voters who supported him.

Democratic headquarters yesterday endeavored to get into communication with each county in the state but they found this impossible. Differences between figures of the democrats and those compiled by the republicans are many but in many other instances they agree on estimated majorities in the various counties.

Helgesen Increases.
Reports received last night only served to increase the lead of Congressman Helgesen in the First district. In the Second district George M. Young of Valley City, progressive republican, probably has doubled the vote cast for James A. Minckler, the democrat. In the Third district the election of P. D. Norton, progressive republican, over Halvor Halvorson, a democrat, is conceded by E. O. Stenwick, campaign manager for Halvorson.

In the gubernatorial race, Adams county gave a plurality to Hanna of 309 votes. Barnes county, with the vote incomplete gave Hanna a lead of 63 votes. Billings county is estimated to have given Hellstrom a plurality of 15 votes. Bottineau county cast 869 votes for Hanna and 785 for Hellstrom, a vote of 303 for Sweet and 314 for Bowen, socialist, being a remarkable feature. In this county Hanna has a plurality of 84 votes.

Cass for Hanna.
Bowman county is placed in the Hanna list by 13 votes. Burke and Burleigh counts have not been completed. Cass county, including Fargo, gave Hanna 2,390 and Hellstrom 1,660. Cavalier county is estimated to have gone for Hellstrom by 250 and Dickey is also placed in the warden's list by 100 plurality. Divide county gave Hanna 739 votes and Hellstrom 293, showing a majority of 446 for Hanna. Norton carried that county over Halvorson by 342 to 286. The count in Dunn county had not been completed late yesterday.

Eddy Goes to Hanna.
Eddy county is estimated to have given Hanna a plurality of 106 votes, Emmons county is placed in the Hanna column with 200 majority. Foster county returns are too incomplete to admit of an estimate. Hanna claims the county and appears to have some basis for his claims. Grand Forks county is claimed by both Hanna and Hellstrom. Griggs county gave Hellstrom a majority estimated by the democratic state committee at 300. Hettinger county with two precincts missing gave Hanna a lead of 483 votes.

Wilson Carries Kidder.
Kidder county is claimed by Hanna and probably will total a plurality for him. LaMoure county is in the Hanna list of 14 votes. Wilson carried that county with Taft his nearest competitor. Logan county had given neither the democrats nor republicans complete figures but is claimed by Hanna by 300 plurality.

McHenry county gave Hanna 76 plurality. McIntosh county is claimed by Hanna by 176 votes. McKenzie is claimed by Hanna by only 100 votes while the democrats claim it by a narrow margin. McLean county, as completed, gave Hanna a lead of 232 votes. Mercer county is claimed by Hanna by 100 votes.

Democrats claim Hanna's plurality in Morton county will not be more than 700 while the republicans claim the plurality of their candidate will total 1,100 or more. Mountrail county is in the Hanna column by 259 plurality. Nelson county also gave Hanna a lead of 140 votes while Oliver county is claimed by Hanna by 150 plurality.

Pembina, the democrats assert, is Hellstrom's territory, but they estimate Hellstrom's plurality at but 100 votes. Republican figures show Hanna has a lead in Pembina of 167 votes. Pierce county, with the returns incomplete, gives Hanna a lead of 10 votes. Ramsey county is claimed by the democrats by 200 votes. Richmond, Rolette, Sargent, Sheridan, and Stark counties are conceded to Hanna.

Steele county is conceded to Hellstrom by 70 votes. Stutsman went for Hanna, by 230 votes; Towner for Hellstrom; Traill for Hellstrom; and Walsh is claimed by them both. Ward county was carried by Hanna by about 130 votes, while Wells county is given to Hanna by 75 votes. Williams county is claimed by the republicans as Hanna territory.

Judiciary Race Close.
The race for judge of the supreme court is very close and it will probably take an official count to decide between Judge A. A. Bruce and James E. Robinson. Robinson it is believed, carried the eastern part of the state but Bruce is running strong in the west.

Latest reports this morning give returns from 424 precincts in the state, giving Wilson 8490, Taft 6467, Roosevelt 6242.

In Fargo.
With almost all of the wards of the city complete and one of the largest votes cast in Fargo for years, Woodrow Wilson and L. B. Hanna lead the ticket. Hanna only lost one ward and that the Sixth, which went to Hellstrom.

Wilson's plurality in Fargo was 83, Taft running second. Helgesen won the city for congress. Porterfield ran ahead in the city for state senator, while the race for members of the lower house between McDonald and Blakemore is close. It may take an official count to decide.

The rest of the state ticket is republican. Robinson defeated Bruce for judge of the supreme court as far as the city is concerned. Indications are that the constitutional amendment for lengthening the terms of supreme court justices was defeated. The other two probably carried in the city, Cass county is republican, Ross running ahead.

Incomplete returns from over the county show that the entire republican state and county tickets have carried with a large majority, but Wilson may carry the county by a small majority.

The latest returns point to a majority for Hanna for Governor of not less than eight to ten thousand and the entire state republican ticket will be elected by about the same majority. Every ward in Valley City gave Hanna a majority and the entire city gave him seventy-four over Hellstrom. He carries nearly every precinct in the county except Leal, which he lost in the primaries.

George M. Young carried the county by eight hundred majority and his election by a large majority is conceded by all party headquarters.

Scattering precincts throughout the state give Taft 822, Wilson 1127, Roosevelt 882. Philadelphia 325 districts out of 1218 give Taft 25650, Roosevelt 15404, Wilson 532.

Reports from New Jersey state that Wilson carry the state with Roosevelt a close second.
