**DIAZ REMAINS AT VERA CRUZ; ORDERED TO RETURN TO CUBA**

**Ex-President Faces Loss of Chance for Presidency or Arrest and Court Martial--17 Are Prisoners.**

Mexico City, Oct. 24.—Revolutionists yesterday murdered the entire population, numbering about fifty, of the village of Cheran Atzicurin in the state of Michoacan, while they were defending the village church against looters. The villagers fought until their ammunition was exhausted and then used machetes, stones and clubs to beat off their assailants, but they were eventually overcome and killed and the village burned to the ground. Rebels are reported to have tortured Lieutenant Jose Bracamontes and two soldiers belonging to a small federal garrison stationed near Camaron, south of Nuevo Laredo, after killing remainder of the federal troops. The rebels are said to have skinned the soles off the feet of their three prisoners, walked them several miles and then beheaded them with machetes because they refused to shut for Carranza.
