LAZINESS IS A DISEASE

(By H. Addington Bruce.) Author of "The Riddle of Personality," "Psychology and Parenthood."

There are some people who will object vigorously to the heading I have given to this article. Laziness, they will protest, is not a disease; it is a vice, a normal infirmity due to weakness of will. But what causes the weakness of will? In Paris a group of scientists undertook a careful investigation of laziness. A number of idlers were rounded up and tested mentally and physically. This important fact became evident.

Without exception the men examined were found to be suffering from a debilitated condition of the nervous system, characterized by a slow heartbeat, a high blood pressure and a poor circulation. This condition was found to exist in idlers who to all outward appearance were strong and healthy. As a consequence of it, sustained effort was virtually impossible to them. For, with their physical state what it was, their brain was so poorly nourished that it quickly tired when concentration of attention on any task was required. This does not mean, though, that these idlers were born lazy. On the contrary, there is plenty of evidence that scarcely anybody is born lazy. One has only to think of the super-abundant activity of every young child in order to realize that, whatever sin be said of it, laziness is an acquired disease. Oftentimes, undoubtedly, the trouble is due to a faulty home upbringing, whereby on the one hand not enough attention is paid to the child's physical needs, and on the other his natural mental activity is dulled, no effort being made to encourage and train him in sustained thinking. By the time he reaches school age he has acquired such poor work habits that study is irksome and burdensome to him. If at the same time, like so many children, he is troubled by adenoid growths, eye-strain, dental defects, etc., he is the more likely, because of the nervous stress, to seek, to develop the debilitated nervous condition found in the idlers of Paris. Above all, he needs a regular exercise to build up his weakened nervous system. He needs thorough examination for the detection of any special physical ailments that may complicate his case. Above all, he needs a skillful guidance in the awakening of a passionate desire to do some specific task, and to do it well. Tonics and astringents are not enough. Intense interest in something while must be aroused. Otherwise, even after he has been physically rejuvenated, the idler will likely slip back into his old ways. For, as the saying is, "It is easier to fall than to rise."
