SLIGHT RAISE IN WHEAT MARKET

Minneapolis, Aug. 10.—Minneapolis September wheat and December wheat closed 2-4 higher. The wheat market was easier at the start and September wheat sold down to \$1.03 3/4 and December to \$1.04 1/4.
