CITY MAKES BOTTLES. Commerce Report: Hicbron, which is one of the oldest cities in Palestine, has long been famous for its water bottles, made of goat skin. These bottles, which are carried to Hebron by camel caravans and sold to the tanneries. Their manufacture into bottles involves several processes and it usually takes a workman week to ready a single skin waterproof and serviceable.

The finished bottles are sent to all parts of the east, thousands being sent into Egypt and the Sudan every year. Besides serving as receptacles for water and other liquids the skins are often inflated and a number of them are attached to a light wooden raft which then floats well and is capable of supporting a heavy load. Rafts of this kind are often seen on the rivers of Syria and on the Euphrates and the Tigris.
