WHEAT CLOSES ONE CENT LOWER

Minneapolis, Nov. 17.—December wheat closed lower, May wheat unchanged. The market opened unheated but turned weaker later in the day with final figures a cent lower than yesterday's closing prices. The market was rather quiet; the range was within comparatively narrow limits. The weather in the northwest was unsettled and a continuation of this was predicted.

Receipts were more liberal in Minneapolis today, wheat today being 635 cars compared with 357 a year ago. Winnipeg today had 1,274 cars against 606 a year ago. Duluth had 742 cars against 352 a year ago. Wheat and flour clearances equalled 1,268,000 bushels.
