
MRS. CORWIN FUNERAL TODAY



Dr. Lee Coulter, Grand Forks Man Who Has Achieved Wide Fame, To Visit Parents Here Two Days

Dr. John Lee Coulter, a Grand Forks man, will arrive in the city for a visit Saturday and Sunday with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Coulter, 622 South Fourth street. Dr. Coulter graduated from the North Dakota university in 1904.

Dr. Coulter is now dean and director of the college of agriculture and experiment station of West Virginia, the institution being located at Morgantown, W. Va. The present contemplated visit to this city of Dr. Coulter is made possible by the fact that he is just now in Chicago, where he is attending the rural credits conference, and where he appeared on the program yesterday.

He was a member of the United States commission to investigate and study rural credits and the agricultural co-operative organization in European countries. He was director of the agricultural census of 1910, and is a statistician and economist of wide repute.
